

Poster

This year, your efforts in the name of science and nature, qualifying you for the Palme verte, 2009-2010, will be presented to the public at the Biodome from May 22, 2010 until Labour Day.

To ensure that your students and their actions receive the honours they deserve, we would ask you to include in your submission a poster summarizing the basics of your project and accomplishments.

Poster specifications

Front:

The poster should be very visual and summarize, in a **few** words, the situation **before** your interventions, your work **during** the project, and the **results** achieved.

Choose from the material you attached to the report one or two of the most representative photographs, images or sketches for each section: before, during and after. Describe them in a few words (caption), and include the title of your project.

Involve your students and their creativity to make your poster attractive, and to ensure that visitors, when they look at it, understand your project and actions.

Back: On a sticker on the back of your poster, enter the following information:

- the title of the project;
- the name of the teacher;
- the grade level;
- the name of the school;
- the city.

Format

The poster must be made up on a cardboard approximately 50,8 cm X 71,12 cm (20 in X 28 in), sold in most book stores.

Mailing

The poster may be rolled up and placed in a rigid cardboard container, and mailed no later than April 15, 2010 to the following address:
